



MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE RULES



MWL 1) One (1) race is needed to make valid a single event and to score it in the MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE

MWL 2) The scoring system for the MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE will assign points (from 20 to 1 progressively decreasing) starting with the top boats finishing depending on the number of boats racing, as follow:

- With at least 30 boats registered at each single event = the first 20 boats to finish will receive points as follow:
 - 1st classified at each event = 20 pts;
 - 2nd place = 19 pt and so on
 -
 - 20th classified = 1 pts.
 - 21st and more = 0 pts.
- When 20 to 29 boats are registered at each single event = the first 15 boats to finish will receive points as follow:
 - 1st classified at each event = 20 pts;
 - 2nd place = 19 pt and so on
 -
 - 15th classified = 6 pts.
 - 16th classified and more = 0 pts.
- When less than 20 boats are registered at each single event = the first 10 boats to finish will receive points as follow:
 - 1st classified at each event = 20 pts;
 - 2nd place = 19 pt and so on
 -
 - 10th classified = 11 pts.
 - 11th classified and more = 0 pts.

MWL 3.1) In the 2019 MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE RANKING, the boats will be scored with new and separate scoring when racing with a different Owner.

MWL 3.2) In the 2019 MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE RANKING - REGIONAL DIVISIONS (USA, EUROPE, ASIA), the boats will be scored with new and separate scoring when racing:

- with a different Owner;
- with a different Sailing Inventory [Ref. IAM2OCR Part III I.2];
To clarify, each Owner/Charter can only use one (1) single Sailing Inventory for the whole season [Ref. IAM2OCR Part III I.2]
- change in the number of crew from what was declared at first event attended. Each boat have to declare the number of crew members (if sailing with 3 or 4) at the registration of the first event and the number of people onboard shall remain the same number for all events for the MELGES 20 WORLD LEAGUE RANKING - REGIONAL DIVISIONS (USA, EUROPE, ASIA) classification. To clarify, the total number of crew members must remain the same for each sanctioned event. A boat sailing with three (3) people onboard at the first event and then four (4) people at the following event will result in the boat being scored as different boat in the World League – Regional division ranking).

MWL 4) No discard will apply

MWL 5) If there is a series-score tie between two or more boats, each boat's race scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat(s) with the best score(s). No excluded scores shall be used.

If a tie remains between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in the last race. Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied boats' scores in the next-to-last race and so on until all ties are broken. These scores shall be used even if some of them are excluded scores.
